
- <u>Website</u> as an information bank: essential information about the Student Union as an organisation, administration, member services, associations, contact information, etc.
- Current affairs: news, releases, blogs, statements, event calendar
- Check that the information and translations on your association on the website are up to date


- Adding: you need text about the event, image, relevant information
- User ID for associations: tietotekniikka@ayy.fi
- Remember: the use of three languages, i.e. Finnish, Swedish and English

- Note: create in Finnish, remember the language versions on the translate tab
- You can also write more text: Component
 Text paragraph






AYY's social media channels

- Mainly trilingual content in Finnish, Swedish and English
- If you want to add content to social media:
 - Think about who you want to reach and what the issue is, choose the channel/s accordingly
 - Is your message clear and understandable?
 - When do you want the message to be published?
 - What kind of image or illustration to choose?
 - Contact Communications Specialist Julia: <u>julia.wihuri@ayy.fi</u>, tell her your matter and she will help you, ask for the translation and publish the message

Briefly about crisis communication

Checklist for crisis communications

- AT THE BEGINNING OF THE YEAR / BEFORE THE EVENT: Choose the person responsible for communications in case of emergency to avoid the broken telephone effect or confusing communication.
- 2. Extent of the crisis: ensure safety, call II2 if necessary and notify AYY (laura.luoto@ayy.fi, tel. <u>+358 40 575 9092;</u> , if unavailable, please contact julia.wihuri@ayy.fi, tel. <u>+358 40 542 2388</u>).
- 3. Tell the truth to those present/the media. The responsibility lies with the person who has been assigned responsibility for crisis communications. Say only what you know and everything you know, do not speculate. Information related to a police investigation is always provided only by the authorities. AYY's communications team is happy to help you and can act as a contact person with the membership and the media, so don't worry.
- 4. Defuse the crisis in your group when the situation is over.
